With this in mind, we wanted to take a moment to reaffirm the Lincoln International High School's commitment to providing a high-quality educational experience in a safe, welcoming environment for every student.

Lincoln International High School follows all applicable laws when it comes to protecting the privacy, safety, and educational rights of our students. For example, we do not request or maintain information about the immigration status of our students or families as part of the enrollment and all Outside agencies are prohibited from entering our school without a valid warrant or court order.

Our strength as a school community comes from treating everyone with dignity and respect so that every child can learn, grow, and thrive. Given the current ICE situation, we would like to assure you that the emotional and physical safety of our students and families is our top priority.

Beginning on Monday January 12th, we will continue to have classes in the building and also offer an online option for students who do not feel safe coming to school. Online students are expected to sign in daily and follow Google classroom activities.
